

## Appendix 7

### **RULES OF THE PERSON RENTING OR RENTING A HOUSE**

1. All persons other than the owner staying more than forty-eight (48) hours at La Paloma must register at the administration office upon arrival.
2. Persons other than the owner-occupier of the house are responsible for reviewing the emergency plan.
3. Everyone must behave in a way that does not disturb the peace of the residents, especially between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m.
4. Appropriate attire is required on site. Shirts, sweaters or bathrobes and shoes are required everywhere on the site, except at the pool.
1. Children under the age of ten (10) must be accompanied by an adult at all times on the streets of La Paloma.  
Children under 10 years old should not play on the pool tables. Teenagers between the ages of ten (10) and sixteen (16) must be accompanied by an adult to play pool and must play at the same table as the responsible adult.
5. The following pets are tolerated with the owner's approval: birds, cats, and dogs under (20) pounds. They are not allowed around the pool or at the recreation center. On the streets, they must be kept on a leash and feces picked up immediately. It is not permitted to unsupervised tethering of animals outside the house. Aggressive and/or noisy pets that cause a disturbance are prohibited. Dogs are tolerated, in the arms of the owner, in the recreation center for very short periods of time (handing in a document, registering for an activity, etc.). Exception to this rule for service animals: see Chapter II, para. 4.0 e).
6. Skateboards are not allowed anywhere in the park. Only in-line skates, bicycles and scooters are allowed on park streets; However, they are prohibited in the recreation centre (including paving stone sidewalks, petanque, multi-sports hall and swimming pool sections).
7. It is forbidden to leave a child twelve (12) years of age or younger unattended at the pool. Children under the age of sixteen (16) are not allowed in the bath tub
8. It is forbidden to allow a child under fifteen (15) years of age to drive a golf cart, as well as to have him or her driven on the lap of an adult: see Chapter II, para. 3.2 d).
9. The maximum speed on the streets of the park is 10 miles/hour (16 kilometers/hour).
10. The only means of transportation allowed on the site are automobiles, minivans, SUVs, golf carts and pick-up trucks. They must be parked in the driveway of the house and not on the street: Chapter II, para. 3.2.
11. No clotheslines or clothes racks are allowed outside the house. It is strictly forbidden to hang or hang towels or clothes anywhere outside the house.
12. Household waste is collected on Wednesdays and Saturdays (Wednesday includes collection). The bins can be put at the curb the night before. Garbage cans and recycling bins must be invisible from the street.
